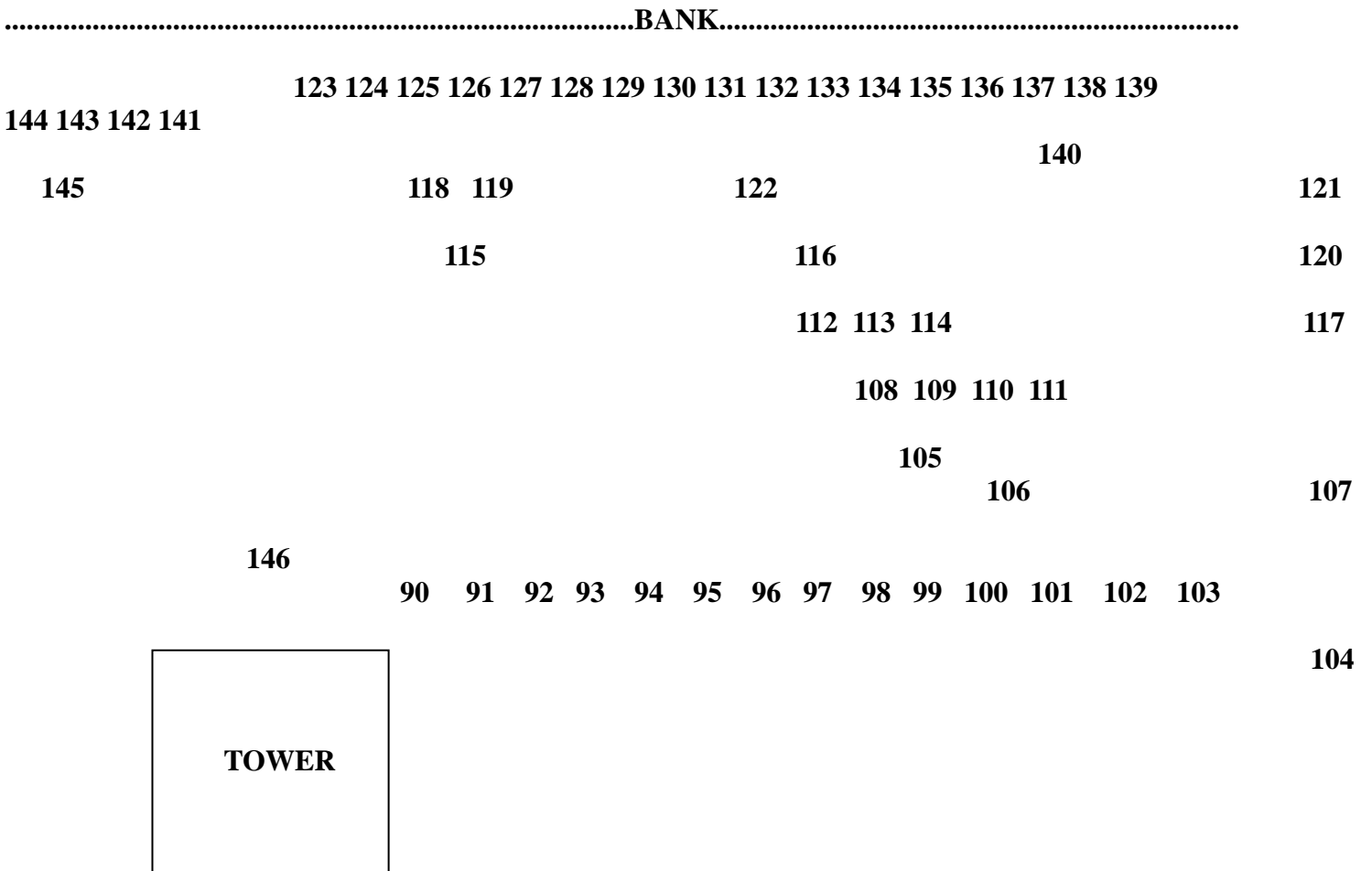


**ST. PETER AND ST. PAUL**

The numbers correspond to the numbers on the plan. No.123 -139 are laying flat on the bank.
