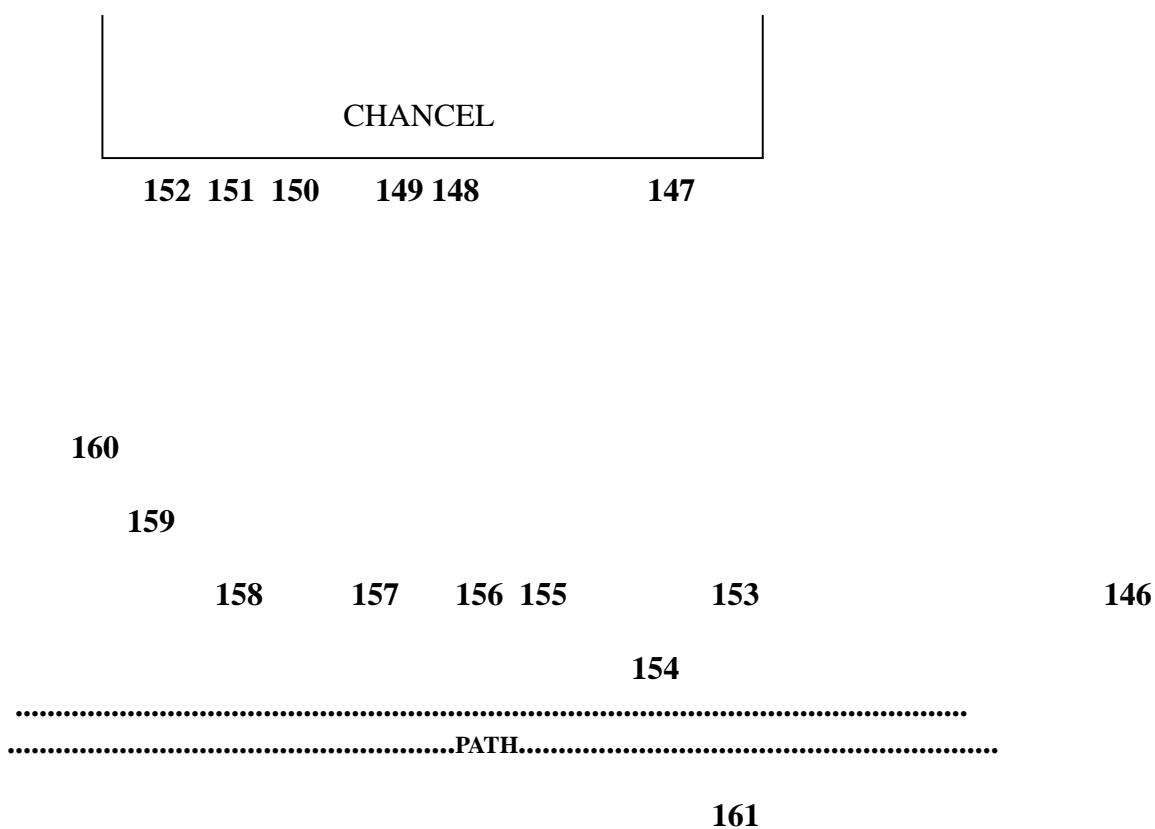


**ST. PETER AND ST. PAUL**
